2023 CAMPSITE CAPACITIES

The H. Roe Bartle Scout Reservation has a comprehensive conservation plan. A major part of the plan addresses the preservation of our natural resources and maintaining our topsoil. The capacity of campsites plays a large part in that plan. In order to make the plan work, it is necessary to adhere to the capacities of each campsite.

Please consider the size that your unit will be next summer when you arrive at camp. Your unit must be able to fit into the capacity of the campsite or it will be necessary to make changes. The changes could be any of the following:

1. Some adult leaders will be required to sleep in open spots in other campsites.
2. Part of your unit may be moved to another campsite.
3. The entire unit may be moved to another campsite or camp.

Because of the conservation plan, we will not move additional platforms into campsites.

Please understand that part time leaders are not guaranteed a specific seat in the dining hall.
