# How do I Register?

1. Complete the registration and personal application forms - see the council website under training
2. Choose the course you want to attend
3. Return to **Program Services** at the Heart of America Council
4. Along with payment, made payable to Heart of America Council (HOAC).
5. Fee for the course is \$200 before August 5<sup>th</sup>. After August 5<sup>th</sup> the fee is \$230.
6. Fee includes all meals and training materials
7. A non-refundable, non-transferable deposit of \$75.00 is required to hold a position.

## Register soon - space is limited!

### What to bring: (equipment list to follow)

- A current Annual Health and Medical Record (you cannot participate without one!)
- Your personal gear for 3 days including two Scout uniforms appropriate for your registered position (you will be required to be in a Scout uniform at all times; either "Field" (Class A) or "Activity" (Class B) uniform).

- A personal tent that is easily carried - for the second weekend only. Again, more on this at the pre-course meeting.
